### **President Updates - Brigid Huey**

1. December: staff had a holiday party and PTSO provided drinks and desserts.
2. This month we will be providing a comfort station for external auditions 1/20-1/22. Snacks, water, bandaids, etc. and info will be provided. Volunteers will be solicited on a sign up genius.
3. February 12: supporting the Black History Month program with a matching donation drive. We will match up to \$400 for this event to cover food costs for cast and crew.
4. Dance for 7th and 8th graders coming April 24th! This will be held right after school from 3:15-5:15 in the cafeteria or gym. Free for students with decorations, food, drinks, and music. Jenny Rachford will need some volunteers and the sign up genius will go out at the end of January. Students will be helping to make the decisions.

### **Administration/Principal Updates**

1. 2nd semester Resetting
  - a. We will reviewing our benchmark and testing data both individually and by grade level
    - i. 3rd grade math team gets a shout out for a 70% success rate on testing at benchmark or above.
  - b. Students will be reminded of expectations in the building.
  - c. Attendance is being evaluated- 25% of our students are considered to be chronically absent. We have an attendance social worker that's working with families. Chronic absences affect test scores, funding, staffing, etc.

2. External auditions are coming up January 20-22
3. An Internal Recruitment Team is in place to determine what we are looking for in these new students- work ethic, grades, commitment, etc.

## Open Question/Answer

**1. Garden Klub (Cybele McGrazi)**-Ms. Martich is leading the Garten Klub effort and has recently spoken to Mr. Draud about some of our progress. In the last month, we were awarded \$1,000 from the Cincinnati Seeds of Change Urban Agriculture Mini-Grant. YAY! We have successfully recruited science teachers Ms. Broerman + Ms. Burns to jump on board; we met with a representative from the City of Cincinnati's Keep Cincinnati Beautiful program who is assisting us with the application for their Safe & Clean Grant; and we plan on officially going public next month by launching a school wide Garten Klub Logo design competition and/or Seeds and Supplies drive.

Discussion followed with the PTSO board
